## Monday Night Pistol League

The Monday Night Recreational Shoot will resume its recreational shooting on September 13 at 7:30 pm on the indoor 50-foot range.

The cost for the 20-week season is \$30 for members and \$40 for non-members. Persons that can't commit to the entire 20-week period can pay as they go, \$3 per night for members and \$4 per night for non-members. You will need your favorite firearm, 50 rounds of ammunition - .22 or center fire with a velocity under 1200 fps, and eye and ear protection. The shoot does have a timed and rapid fire segment so a semiautomatic pistol is recommended; however, those with revolvers and speed loaders will have time to complete the lines. ## Open Trap Shooting
