Monday Night Pistol League

The Monday Night Recreational Shoot will finish their Monday night pistol shoots mid March and will begin shooting steel silhouettes at 7:30 pm on the indoor 50-ft range. The silhouette shoot will continue through May when they will move outside for their bowling pin shoots.

The cost for the silhouettes is \$2 per line with the winner of the line getting his money back. The course is 10 shots at each of 3 separate metal targets (chickens, groundhogs, and pigs) for a total of 30 shots per line.

You will need your favorite 22 calibre firearm, 30 rounds of ammunition per line (with a velocity under 1200 fps), and eye and ear protection. Each 10-shot round of shooting is timed at 1 minute.

Club Training - NRA Courses Basic Pistol Shooting

This 8-hour course is scheduled for Saturday, March 28, 2015 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. There are no prerequisites. The

cost is \$75 for non-Club members or \$60 for Club members. **Basic Personal Protection in the** Home

This 8-hour course is scheduled for Saturday, September 5, 2015 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

Participants in this course must be experienced shooters, be able to show the mastery of the basic skills of safe gun handling, shooting groups, zeroing the firearm, and cleaning the firearm. The cost is \$75 for non-Club members or \$60 for Club members.

Basic/Advanced Personal Protection Outside the Home

This 14-hour course is scheduled for Saturday November 7 and 14, 2015 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm each day.

Participants must be experienced shooters, be able to show the mastery of the basic skills of safe gun handling, drawing and re-holstering a firearm, shooting groups, zeroing the firearm, and cleaning the firearm. They must also have taken the Personal Protection in the Home Course, or equivalent, or pass a pre-course assessment test. The cost is \$150 for non-Club member or \$120 for Club members.

To take the course, the following items are required:

Handgun

A handgun that is practical to carry concealed.

Work Parties

Work Parties are held on the 3rd Saturday of each month to do maintenance and improvements around the Club. These work parties (Club volunteers) are a critical part of Club operation. Without proper maintenance and an effort to improve the Club, members would find it more and more difficult to use the Club's facilities.

The Directors ask everyone who can to donate some time to these work parties. Lunch is provided.

Holster or Holster Purse

A holster or holster purse designed for concealed carry and the handgun you will use in the class. It must be one that will permit presentation of the firearm from the strong side only and must be concealment style hip/belt type.

No exclusively competition style holsters or holster purses are permitted.

The holster or holster purse must provide secure retention and be designed to prevent the trigger finger from entering the gun's trigger guard when the gun is holstered.

Ammunition

Ammunition can be lead or jacketed, under 1200 fps, and no +P or +P+ is allowed.

A minimum of 206 rounds will be required but participants are urged to bring extra ammunition. The Basic Course requires a minimum of 94 rounds and the Advanced Course requires a minimum of 112 rounds. Participants will be taking both courses.

Speed Loaders/Magazines

Speed loaders and magazines are required along with speed loader or magazine pouches (pouches are optional if carrying the speed loader or magazine in your pocket/purse).

• Clothing

Concealed carry clothing such as a jacket, sport coat, or vest is required.

Miscellaneous

Knee pads (if you need them). Eye and ear protection. Handgun owner's manual.
