New Voice-Activated System at Trap Range

We recently completed installation of a voice activated system at the trap range.
The system responds to the shooter's "Pull" command and launches the bird. Each station has its own audio detector that listens for a shooter's command. This is more responsive to the shooters and eliminates the lag time in a hand-controlled system.

The cost for the silhouette shoot is \$2 per line with the winner of the line getting their money back. The course of fire is 10 shots at each of three separate metal targets (chickens, groundhogs, and pigs) for a total of 30 shots per line.

You will need your favorite .22 calibre firearm, 30 rounds of ammunition per line (with a velocity under 1200 fps), and eye and ear protection. Each 5-shot round of shooting is timed at 1 minute.

There is no need to sign up for the Monday Night Silhouette Shoot; just come to the Club about 7:15 pm and check in.

The group will move to the outdoor 50-yard range for their summer Monday Night Bowling Pin Shoot in June.

The recreational Pistol League will begin its 20-week season in September. The cost to participate is \$30 for Club members. They take a break after 10 weeks (about Thanksgiving time) and start their second 10-week session after New Year's Day.
